EXHIBIT B TUSCOLA FIRE DEPARTMENT

COMMUNITY BUILDING LIFE SAFETY RULES

All exit signs must be lighted and visible at all times

Exit doors must be unlocked and readily accessible at all times

DO NOT BLOCK EXITS. No one may place any object of any kind in a manner that would block an exit or impede the normal traffic flow and pattern thereto.

All displays, exhibits, decorations, and other improvements constructed, or containing combustible material, shall be limited in number and size to not create any undue hazard that might endanger lives or property and shall be approved by the Fire Department.

NO PYROTECHNICS ARE ALLOWED WITHOUT APPROVAL OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

If candles are to be used and lit, they shall be placed and secured in a non combustible holder designed to not allow the candle to be easily knocked over, not in close proximity to combustible materials, and shall be approved by the Fire Department prior to the event.

SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE COMMUNITY BUILDING.

No vehicles shall be parked directly in front of the building during the event (yellow zone).

Occupant Load of the Main Assembly Area

When tables and chairs are used, the maximum number of occupants shall be 300. When only chairs are used, the maximum number of occupants shall be 475. Any time that tables and or chairs are used they shall be

arranged with the aisles leading to exits.

The Fire Department and Police Department of the City of Tuscola are authorized and directed to enforce these rules and regulations. The Fire Dept. or Police Dept. may enter the building at any time for the purpose of inspection of the building. Should overcrowding or any other violation be observed, the Fire Chief or his subordinate or the Police Dept. may take such steps as necessary to eliminate the hazardous condition or violation.
