## **Contracts and Agreements**

A quote from Zoll Medical Corporation for the replacement of seven outdated Automatic External Defibrillators (AED) was presented for council discussion. The AED's will replace seven of our outdated units Chief Moody recommends replacing. Hoey moved to approve the purchase of seven AED's from Zoll Medical in the amount of \$16,955.33. Slaughter seconded. VOTE YEA\* Brace, Day, Hoey, Rund, Shoemaker, Slaughter, Waldrop.

Quotes have been obtained for the replacement of the HVAC system at City Hall. The 20 year old system has had several major parts replaced over the years and the heating/cooling in the building is no longer effective. Building Inspector Salmon recommends going with the low proposal submitted by All Pro and hopefully having the system installed this spring when heat and AC are not in high demand. Slaughter moved to waive formal bidding on the HVAC system and installation for City Hall. Brace seconded. VOTE YEA\* Brace, Day, Hoey, Rund, Shoemaker, Slaughter, Waldrop. Waldrop moved to approve the proposal submitted by All Pro for the replacement of the HVAC system at City Hall at a cost of \$57,830.00. Slaughter seconded.
