

To ensure the safety and family atmosphere of the pool, we DO NOT ALLOW.....

Smoking within the fence.

Glass items of any kind.

Inappropriate Language.

Inappropriate displays of public affection.

No dirty/muddy shoes on the pool deck.

Throwing of children or having them on shoulders of another person.

Running.

Diving off the sides.

Fighting/Pushing/Shoving.

Swimming in street clothes.

Rafts, rings and throwing objects are left to the discretion of the manager and lifeguards.

FOOD

Outside food is allowed with management being allowed to search through any cooler brought into the pool area. Food must be consumed in the concession area. Clean up is your responsibility. Parties are encouraged to use the picnic area outside the pool area for consumption of food.

DIVING BOARD

No arm flotation's/rings or goggles allowed.

Must be able to go off straight and swim to closest ladder.

Life jackets are allowed.

No sitting along the diving well.

No excessive bouncing on diving boards.

SLIDE

Life jackets are encouraged. No rings/arm flotations or goggles allowed.

Weight limit 200 lbs.

Only one person at a time permitted down the slide.

BABY POOL

Not under lifeguard supervision. Must have adult supervision within fenced baby pool area. Swim Diapers are required on those not potty trained. Appropriate for ages 5 and under.



Children under 10 must be accompanied by:

An adult, parent or legal guardian; or

*A sibling 10 or older, but only if the child is at least 8; or

*A babysitter 13 years or older

*Parent or legal guardian must authorize initially at the cashier desk. No more than 2 children under 10 per older sibling or babysitter.

Admission and Pool Pass Cards

Daily entry - paid at the pool
\$5 per person for all day

Pass Cards - Order on-line at www.tuscola.org/pool

Individual Season Pass - Pass card for all season, unlimited entry for one individual. Card is not transferrable or shareable. - \$35

Entry Card Pass- Pass card for multiple entries during the season. Card may be used for anyone or for multiple individuals.

- 10 entries for \$30
- 20 entries for \$50
- 50 entries for \$100

- Photo if individual season pass
- Payment

Private Rentals

Private Rentals of the pool are available from 8-10 PM daily beginning June 1. To reserve complete the on-line form at www.tuscola.org/pool. The rental cost of \$200 covers a 2 hours rental for up to 50 attendees. Additional attendees cost \$2 each. Adult chaperones (counted as attendees) must remain in the pool area at all times during the rental. Lifeguards are provided for private parties and all pool rules apply at all times.

Operating Season and Hours

The Tuscola pool will open for the season on May 27, 2023 (early close for graduation) and will close for the season at the beginning of the Tuscola CUSD #301 school year.

Hours of operation will be **12:30-7:30 daily** with adult only swim hours 11:30-12:30 daily

The Tuscola Pool reserves the right to deviate from these hours for any of several conditions out of the control of the management of the pool or that are operationally necessary. Listed below are some common reasons for closing the pool.

- The pool will close any time the temperature is below 70° F.
- The pool will close when audible thunder or visible lightning is detected by the management or staff or if management or staff deems other dangerous weather conditions exist.
- The pool will close anytime repairs or maintenance necessitate closure. A sign will be posted as to the anticipated re-opening time/date. All measures will be taken to get work completed to allow re-opening as quickly as possible.
- The pool will close at any time staffing is not sufficient to maintain safety and legal requirements. Management will take action to ensure staffing issues are kept to a minimum.
- When pool attendance drops to a level that it is no longer operationally feasible to keep staff on the clock, the management may decide to close the facility for the day.

Pool admission passes are purchased at the customer's risk. When pool management or staff determines that the pool must close for these or other unforeseen reasons, **NO** refund or partial refund of season or daily admission passes will be considered.



Proper swim attire required. Revealing or thong style swim wear is not allowed. Street clothes, under garments or other clothes not specifically made for swimming pools are not allowed as they may introduce contaminants into the pool water, bleed color into the water or cause water chemistry to become less effective.

The Tuscola pool is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
