Resolutions

Contracts and Agreements

1. Shoemaker moved to approve a lease of the pool concession area to Andy Romine for operation of the Tropical Sno concession. This is a three-month lease with the same rental terms as previous years. Brace seconded. VOTE YEA* Brace, Day, Hoey, Morris, Shoemaker, Slaughter.
2. Hoey moved to approve the one-year maintenance contract with Power Grid Partners for wind turbine service through June 4, 2027, at a cost of \$7220.00. Slaughter seconded. VOTE YEA* Brace, Day, Hoey, Morris, Shoemaker, Slaughter.

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3. Hoey moved to approve the quotes from QWF Electric in the amount of \$9,141.41. The quotes cover replacing north tennis court lights with LED's and an upgrade to the electrical service at the girls' softball diamond. Morris seconded. 4. Shoemaker moved to approve the agreement with GFI for the purchase and maintenance of two Sharp copiers at a cost of \$13,000.00. Day seconded. VOTE YEA* Brace, Day, Hoey, Morris, Shoemaker, Slaughter.
