## Tourism Board Meeting March 18, 2014

The meeting was called the meeting to order approximately 8:30 am. In attendance: Randy Hastings, Ashley Swinford, Donna Kidwell, Devon Flesor, Drew Hoel, Alta Long, and Anna Marx.

Motion to approve the minutes from the February 18, 2014 Board meeting made by Donna, seconded by Devon. All in favor, motion passed.

Motion to approve the bills list from 2/14/14-3/14/14, in the amount of \$2,339.74 made by Randy, seconded by Devon. All in favor, motion passed.

## Old Business:

Drew gave the board an update on combining Chamber of Commerce operations with Tourism and TEDI boards. They are still waiting on the bylaws to be drafted. He expects those to be completed within the next few weeks.

Alta updated the board on the IDOT- Tourist Oriented Directional Signing Program. The signs went up last week and include The Vault, Vintage Karma, and the Candy Kitchen. Winterberry is waiting on approval. All members were very pleased with how fast the signs went up. The businesses received approval March 10<sup>th</sup> and the signs were put up March 13<sup>th</sup>.

Alta reviewed the draft budget with the board members. She noted that the CVB grant will be increasing to \$20,000 and the budget will also include marketing for the furniture stores and hotels. The board also discussed continuing support of the Vault Events. Alta suggested helping them advertise their events specifically.

Kim Higgins addressed the board on behalf of the Douglas County Museum about their pledge drive. The museum board members feel it is imperative to hire a museum director in order to keep the doors open. The Board members agreed to a 2 year pledge of \$10,000 per year to the museum for this purpose, if they are successful in raising \$80,000 in 2 year pledges and use that money to hire a full time employee. Drew made a motion to approve the budget with a \$10,000 pledge for the museum, seconded by Devon. All in favor, motion passed.

New Business:

A grant application for the IDOT- Tourist Oriented Directional Signing Program was submitted by Flesor's Candy Kitchen for \$240. A motion to approve was made by Randy, and seconded by Ashley.

A grant application for the IDOT- Tourist Oriented Directional Signing Program was submitted by Winterberry for \$240. A motion to approve was made by Ashley, and seconded by Randy.

A grant application was submitted by Kiwanis for the Tuscola Community Easter Egg Hunt. The grant money will be used to purchase several banners that will be able to be used year after year. A motion to approve was made by Devon and seconded by Donna.

Alta updated the board on the Sparks in the Park planning. Ashleigh and Drew Sterkel have volunteered to be the event coordinators. Anna has also has reserved all the volunteers from last year. The variety show is still in need for a coordinator.

The 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Amish Country Tractor Cruise will be making a lunch stop in Tuscola at the park this year. The cruise will include 125-130 tractors. The event coordinator, Jim Flemming, requested goody bags. For the event we are planning to provide goody bags, welcome banner, and reach out to the FFA to see if they are interested in becoming involved. Wes Wheeler will be performing at the market that morning so Alta will see if he would like to perform for the tractor cruise at the park during their lunch.
