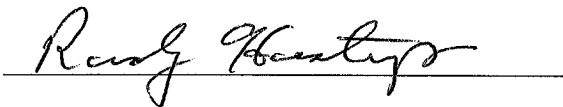

Tourism Board Meeting

May 15, 2018

The meeting was called to order approximately 8:30 am. In attendance: Donna Kidwell, Drew Hoel, Randy Hastings, Ashley Swinford, Alta Long, and Anna Nelson.

Motion to approve the minutes from March 20, 2018 and April 17, 2018 board meeting was made by Donna, seconded by Ashley. All in favor motion passed.

A motion to approve the bills list from 3/16/18- 4/13/18 in the amount of \$7,861.92 and 4/13/18-5/11/18 in the amount of \$15,87032 made by Randy, seconded by Donna. All in favor motion passed.

Old Business:

Anna explained they plan to launch the history map August 17, the same afternoon as the live WCIA production. They plan to add as much information as possible to the map by the end of May. Then they will start the editing phase and final touches.

Anna updated the board on Sparks in the Park. JFL will be getting teams together for the Knockerball tournament. They plan to have several games that evening. So far they have 4 food vendors signed and expect several more in the next few weeks. Anna asked the board if they would like have Benchworx, the woodworking classes for kids, back this year. The cost is \$900 and 48 kids will be able to participate. The board was in favor of bringing them back this year.

Anna reminded the board the first Outdoor Movie Night and Artisan Market is this Friday. She has 5 vendors signed up and hopes to add more throughout the season.

Anna updated the board on the WEIU- Our Story project. They currently do not have the funding for the project. They need to raise at least \$12,000 to do the project in Tuscola. Anna explained that she has met with community members to help spread the word out the upcoming project. They've had very positive feedback. The board has already committed to pledge \$2,000 toward the project. Drew made a motion to contribution to \$4,000 with the contingency that they must raise \$12,000 or more. Donna seconded. All in favor motion passed.

Anna updated the board on the WCIA Our Town live segment. Anna has formed a committee for this project and they have met with WCIA about the live event. Anna is working with this group to get different organizations involved. Kiwanis has agreed to serve hot dogs and brats that day. She will keep the board updated as she learns more.

New Business:

Kiwanis Club requested the board reconsider the grant for the Drive-up Drug Collection. They felt it would bring visitors to town as they were advertising in regional paper. After much discussion the board felt that this project did not qualify for a tourism grant.

The Rural Life Antique Show grant request for the March show advertising was approved by Randy and seconded by Drew. All in favor motion passed.

The Flesor's Candy Kitchen grant request for the Tourism Directional signage was approved by Randy and seconded by Donna. All in favor motion passed.

Drew asked the board if they would like to step down from the board to let them know. If not, they will recommend the current board for reappointment. Anna mentioned she has someone interested in being added to the board. Anna said she will check the ordinance and see if there is a spot available.

Alta share information about the Champaign county marketing partnership. They would like to partner with Tuscola to help promote the entire area. We would be included in their visitor guide, website and can be added to

the Illinois tourism website. They will also include Tuscola in their bus tours. Randy mentioned this will be great for our downtown as well as the outlet mall. The contribution is \$5,000 for this partnership. Randy made a motion to approve and seconded by Donna. All in favor motion passed.
